Birak is referred to as the 'burning season', when we have hot and dry weather. The season's colour is red, symbolised by the spectacular colours of the sky at sunrise and sunset.

Traditionally Noongar people would initiate controlled burning to regenerate the land.

Flame (djarliny) provides heat to release seeds and smoke (koorl), followed by rains helps seeds to germinate.
