Wardong (crows and ravens) start pairing up and Maali (black swans) begin nesting. The cold, wet and windy weather brings strong southwesterly winds, that made traditional people move inland. The bush turns green, with fungi emerging and blue and purple flowers bloom



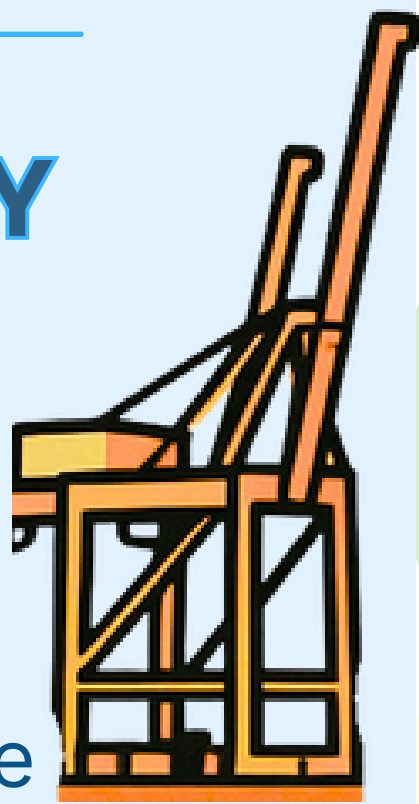

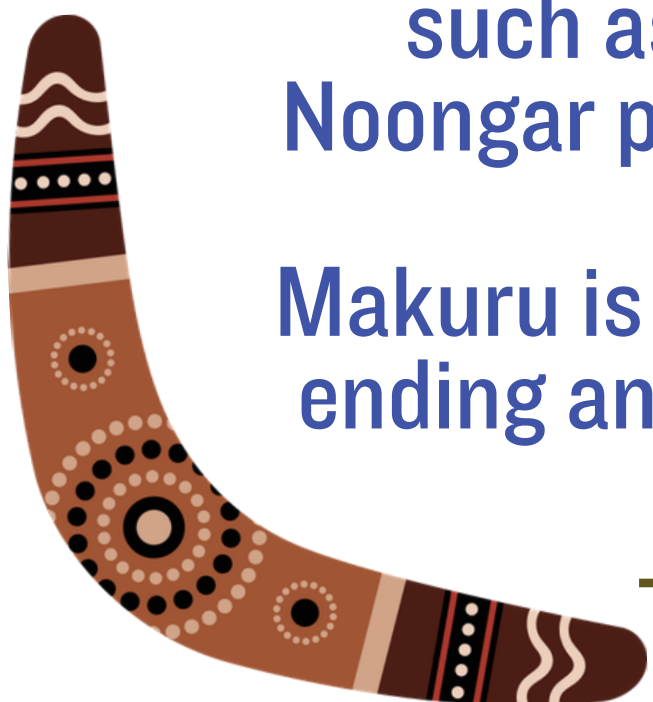

Makuru's heavy rains bring the blooming of wildflowers such as scarlet bankisia and kangaroo paws. Noongar people traditionally used fire to keep warm and to make tools for hunting. Makuru is a time of transition, with the rainy season ending and warmer temperatures arriving in Djilba.
